

## WILSON YOUTH SOFTBALL PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT



I (we) will remember that kids participate to have fun, and that the game is for the kids not adults.

I (we) will be a positive role model(s) for our children and encourage sportsmanship.

I (we) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any coach, player, umpire or other parents such as booing, taunting or using profane or inappropriate gestures. (Liberty-Wilson Youth Softball has a ZERO tolerance policy for any of the behaviors listed above).

I (we) will encourage our child to play by the rules.

I (we) will ensure that my child will be courteous to players, coaches, umpires and other parents.

I (we) will encourage playing fair and trying hard; over winning at all costs.

I (we) will never ridicule another child for mistakes made during practices or games.

I (we) will put heavy emphasis on skill development.

I (we) will respect umpires and their decisions during games. I will never question or confront coaches or umpires on the field. I may speak with coaches about concerns at an agreed upon place and time.

I (we) will ensure the children play in an environment free of tobacco, alcohol, and drugs and I will refrain from using tobacco, alcohol, and drugs at practices and games.

I (we) will refrain from coaching my child and other players **during** games *UNLESS* I am a head coach or assistant coach approved by LYS.

I (we) will abide by all rules/policies of LYS and the Wilson School District while at practices and games, including the no pet policy.
